POINTS.

A competitor gains 2 points for reaching the standard for the event during the preliminary rounds. The standards are printed in the programme.

No standards are fixed in 80 yards, 100 yards and Hurdle events. In these, each competitor reaching the semi-final gains 2 points. If, however, there are so few entries that the semi-final is the only preliminary round, each competitor reaching the final gains 2 points. If no preliminary rounds are held, these points are not awarded.
